Last edition we had some Wyoming railroad history, including collisions. Shortly after that, we heard from a reader who said they used to live near where the tracks crossed Green Street. As she recalled, it was an afternoon in 1959 and was starting to rain. A young girl, just 16, was rushing down Green Street to get home to shut the windows. In her haste, she didn't see the approaching train and drove into it, with her car getting hooked on the engine and drug until the engine could stop. No one was hurt.
