ORDINANCE HIGHLIGHT:

Chapter 46 MINORS - Ordinance 46.01 Curfew

- Subsection 2.A – "Curfew hours" means ten o'clock (10:00)p.m. until five o'clock (5:00) a.m. of the following day on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday; and eleven o'clock (11:00) p.m. until five o'clock (5:00) a.m. on Friday and Saturday.
- Subsection 2.E – "Minor" means any person under seventeen (17) years of age.
