Winter reminders:

- No parking on streets during snow removal. Cars may be ticketed. Better access for work crews means faster clean-up times.
- Snow and ice should be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours from the time it ceases to accumulate. Please sprinkle any ice accumulations on sidewalks with sand and/or salt to allow safe travel.
- Keep all fire hydrants clear of snow. In an emergency, every second counts! Three feet (3') of access around hydrants is requested. Remember: emergency vehicles need clear access through streets so be mindful when you park vehicles on the street.
- Please help your mail carrier by clearing snow around your mailbox, if you have one located at the street.
- If your home has a tendency toward freezing pipes in extreme cold temperatures, be sure to leave a small trickle of water run from your faucet.
- Snowmobiles should only travel on approved routes within city limits and not on personal property.
