The City allows for a sewer credit based on the water consumption needed to fill the pool. Call or stop in at City Hall to obtain the form needed for the sewer credit. This is a once-a-year credit only.

Reminder: If you have a chicken permit which needs to be renewed yearly, please stop into the City Office to renew, if needed.

City of Wyoming Ordinance 399:41.11.3 Consumer Fireworks:

- A. It is unlawful for any person to sue or explode consumer fireworks on days other than June 1 through July 8 and December 10 through January 3 of each year.
- B. It is unlawful for any person to use or explode consumer fireworks at times other than between the hours of 9am and 10pm, except on the following dates between the hours specified:
 - a. Between the hours of 9am and 11pm on July 4 and Sat. and Sun. immediately preceding and following July 4.
 - b. Between the hours of 9am on Dec. 31 and 12:30am on the following day.
 - c. Between the hours of 9am and 11pm on the Sat. and Sun. immediately preceding and following Dec. 31.
- C. It is unlawful for any person to use consumer fireworks on real property other than the person's real property or on the real property of a person who has consented to the use on that property.
