April 29, 1920 – For Sale – Barred Rock Eggs, 10 for \$1.50; 100 for \$8.00. Orders taken for baby chicks. Mrs. Chas Atherton

April 15, 1937 – A new poultry house was completed on the Fred Fritz farm south of Wyoming this week. The new structure, of modern design, will furnish housing for several hundreds of chickens. Mr. Fritz has already bought more than 500 chicks and has placed 800 additional eggs with a Wyoming hatchery. *(Ed note: The Fritz farm was where Marlyn Lehrman now lives. The Wyoming Historical Museum has an incubator which was used in the Wyoming hatchery business.)*

March 31, 1927 – In Jones County graveling of No. 117 from Anamosa to Wyoming, 15.3 miles will be completed this year. The road from Oxford Junction to Onslow will be bridged, graded and drained in the coming season if present plans are carried out.
