NOTICE: Wyoming City Hall will be closed on Memorial Day, Monday, May 25, 2026.

Swimming Pool Fill – The City allows for a sewer credit based on the water consumption needed to fill the pool. Stop in the City Hall office to pick up a pool fill request form before you fill. This is a once-a-year credit.

The flushing of water hydrants has begun. City maintenance staff will be flushing hydrants on the third Monday and Tuesday of every month, weather permitting. Please note: if you experience discoloration, you need to run your water until it is clear. Remember to check the hot water. This water is safe. Low water pressure may be experienced; you should leave your faucets off until pressure is restored. Customers with a water softener should bypass them during flushing to prevent any problems.

Annual Grass and Weed Abatement Notice:

Grasses, weeds, brush, dense growth shall be kept at a maximum of six inches in residential, business, and industrial property from May 1st to October 31st. **No other notice will be given** before the City will abate the notice and shall assess all costs incurred to the property.

Open burning of yard waste only is allowed March 15th to June 1st. All fires must be out by dark. Buring of any trash, leaves, rubbish or other material in any curb or gutter or on any paved street or alley is prohibited. To prevent plugging of storm drains or culverts, do not put yard waste into storm or street ditches. There is no dumping in Little Bear Creek.

Midland School news: Early dismissal days are May 6th and 13th. The graduation ceremony for 2025-26 seniors will be Sun., May 17th. Last day of school will be May 21st with early dismissal at 1:00pm.

NOTICE: City Ordinance Chapter 51: Junk and Junk Vehicles.

51.01 The purpose of this chapter is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and safety or property of the City by providing for the elimination of the open storage of junk and junk motor vehicles and machinery except in authorized places.

51.02.2B "Junk vehicle" means any vehicle legally placed in storage with the County Treasurer or unlicensed or has any one of the following characteristics: broken glass; broken, loose or missing part; habitat for nuisance animals or insects; flammable fuel; inoperable; defective or obsolete condition.

51.03 It is unlawful for any person to store, accumulate, or allow to remain on any property in the person's control any junk or junk vehicle.
