Open burning ends December 1st. Burning is prohibited in any curb and gutter, paved or surfaced street or alley. This includes culverts. Fires need to be out by dusk.

Garbage pickup days are November 14^{th} , and 29^{th} . Recycling days are November 7^{th} and 21^{st} . Call Kluesner Sanitation to report missed garbage or recycling at 563-927-5977.

Winter reminders...no parking on streets during snow removal. Snow and ice should be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours from the time it ceases to accumulate. If ice has accumulated and cannot be removed keep the sidewalk sprinkled with sand and/or salt to permit safe travel.

Snowmobiles may only operate to go to or from the country by the most direct route: State Street, Pine Street, Green Street and Jones Street. Jefferson Street from Main to Jones to allow for fueling. Any person not living on a designated street may travel by the most direct route to the nearest street designated.
