Open burning of yard waste can begin September 15<sup>th</sup>-  
December 1<sup>st</sup>. Fires must be out by dark. Burning of any trash,  
leaves, rubbish, or other combustible material in any curb and  
gutter or on any paved or surfaced street or alley is prohibited.  
Report illegal fires to the Jones County Sheriff's office.

Sewer Rates have increased 2% effective your current bill for  
September. \$70 increased \$1.40 to \$71.40, \$10 increased \$0.20  
to \$10.20, and \$75 increased \$1.50 to \$76.50.

**Reminder of Ordinance 55.18 #2, no owner or walker of any  
animal shall permit the animal to discharge feces upon any  
public or private property, other than the property of the  
owner of the animal. The owner or walker shall be deemed  
to permit the animal's discharge of feces if the owner does  
not immediately thereafter take the steps to remove and  
clean up the feces from the property.**

The City of Wyoming will be flushing hydrants on  
September 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. Customers  
may experience rust in the system due to the process,  
caution should be taken when doing laundry to prevent  
stains. If you do experience discoloration you need to run  
your water until it is clear. Remember to check the hot  
water. This water is safe. Low water pressure may be  
experienced, you should leave your faucets off until  
pressure is restored. Customers with a water softener  
should by-pass them during the day to prevent any  
problems. Thank you for your cooperation.

Garbage recycling days are September 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>.
