means any unlicensed vehicle stored within the city limits which
has one of the following: broken glass, parts broken, missing,
habitat for animals, flammable fuel or inoperable. Please be
sure to take care of any weeds also. Thank you.

BURNING of any trash, leaves, rubbish or other material in any
curb or gutter or on any paved street or alley is prohibited. To
prevent plugging of storm drains or culverts do not put yard
waste into storm or street ditches. There is no dumping in Little
Bear Creek. Do not blow your grass into the street when
mowing. Open burning ends Dec. 1st.
