

Calkins Square

Step back in time at Calkins' Square, home of Dr. Martin Calkins, a country doctor and Wyoming's first Mayor. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the earliest part of the house was built in 1858. The doctor's office and a monument built as a memorial to the soldiers of Wyoming who served in the Civil War are also located on the square. The doctor's office, along with the home still contains the original items used by Dr. Calkins and his family.
