## ATV AND SNOWMOBILE ROUTE

The following are the designated streets upon which all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles may be operated only to go to or from the country by the most direct route: State Street, Pine Street, Green Street and Jones Street. Jefferson Street from Jones Street to Main Street to allow for fueling at Casey's. Any person not living on a designated street may travel by the most direct route to the nearest street designated.

### Winter Reminder for Wyoming residents

Vehicles shall not be parked on streets during snow removal. Tickets will be issued and vehicles may be towed. City snowplows will not clear private driveways or private property, such as parking lots, except in an emergency. The removal of snow placed in a driveway or on sidewalks by snowplows is the responsibility of the property owner. During periods of heavy snowfall accumulations, there may be times when City equipment cannot physically place all the snow from the curb line onto the City right-of-way. It is the responsibility of the resident to remove snow and ice accumulations from the approach and exits to mailboxes to allow the mail carrier to deliver mail safely and efficiently. It is a violation to cause snow and ice from private property to be placed onto the street.

**Removal of snow and ice from sidewalks shall be done promptly. Within 24 hours.**
