Heating Assistance- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) applications are now being taken. You will need proof of income for everyone 19 and older, SS#'s for everyone in the household, a recent heat bill and recent electric bill.

The City now has a site for disposal of **brush and tree trimmings!** Residents must pick up the key at City Hall and sign the liability agreement. No grass clippings or leaves. Loading and transporting is the responsibility of the resident. Six inch diameter limit. Only for tree and brush trimmings which originate from within the City may be disposed of in the facility. Larger than six inch diameter contact City Hall.

Wyoming Delinquent Utility Bills
Utility bills are mailed the last business day of the month and are due the 10th of the next month. Second notice is printed the 15th with the penalty charge included and sent. Shut off notices for accounts owing \$30 or more are posted on doors the 25th (or the following work day if it is the weekend) and water is shut off the 26th (or following work day if it's the weekend) by 1:30p.m. A fee of \$20 is charged for posting shutoff notices and a fee of \$50 is charge for turning services off and back on.
