March 10th Daylight Savings Time begins!



Time to think spring and clear the clutter! Residents are encouraged to maintain lawns and properties. City code requires proper-

ties be kept free of weeds, rubbish, debris, junk and junk vehicles. Grasses, weeds, brush, dense growth shall be kept at a maximum of 6" from May 1st to October 31st. It is the duty of the owner of the abutting property to keep the trees on, or overhanging the street, trimmed so that all branches will be at least 15 feet above the street and eight feet above the sidewalks. Any trees suspected to be dead, diseased or damaged should be reported to City Hall. If the trees are located in the right-of-way the City may remove the trees if they are dead, diseased or damaged.

Wyoming's FY 2020 Budget
