WYOMING CITY ELECTION NOVEMBER 5, 2019

One of the most challenging and exciting responsi-
bilities an individual can assume is to become a
mayor or council member. The business of city
government and local leadership presents a unique
opportunity to resolve issues, accomplish goals, and
affect the future of your community.

The City of Wyoming conducts business on the sec-
ond Monday of each month. The meetings are gen-
erally held at 7:00 PM, with additional work ses-
sions anticipated during budget season (January -
March) and special meetings when necessary. An-
nual compensation for council members is \$40.00
per meeting. Annual compensation for the mayor is
\$2,000 annually.

The City of Wyoming has two; four-year term
council positions on the ballot this year. Also on
the ballot is the Mayor, which is a two- year term.
In order to hold office in the city, a candidate must
be an eligible elector, meeting the same qualifica-
tions required to vote and be a resident of the city he
or she plans to serve. Nomination papers may be
picked up at the City Clerk's office in City Hall or
online at [http://sos.iowa.gov/elections/election info/
cityelections.html](http://sos.iowa.gov/elections/election%20info/cityelections.html). Nominees must obtain ten eligi-
ble signatures. Candidate filing begins Monday, Au-
gust 26 and ends with papers due at the **County
Auditor's** office by 5 PM Thursday, September 19.
