Annual Grass and Weed Abatement Notice- Grasses, weeds, brush, dense growth shall be kept at a maximum of 6" in residential, business and Industrial property from May 1 to October 31. No other notice will be given before the City will abate the notice and shall assess all costs incurred to the property. The property owner has the right to appeal the matter to the City Council under Section 50.08 of the City Code of Ordinances. For more information contact the Clerk's office.

COVID-19 POLICY for utility bills. City Hall will be closed until the Governor's Proclamation allows for it open. City Hall will be staffed. You may go to wyomingia.org, click on the City Hall page, scroll down and click on pay port to pay your water bill. The City will waive the fees for credit and debit cards. April delinquent notices will be sent out but late fees will not be given. May billing will return to regular policy. This may be extended until the state of emergency is over. Customers must fill out a payment agreement in order to avoid shut off.

The City of Wyoming will be flushing hydrants on Tuesday and Wednesday, April 21 & 22, weather permitting. Customers may experience rust in the system due to the process, caution should be taken when doing laundry to prevent stains. If you do experience discoloration you need to run your water until it is clear. Remember to check the hot water. This water is safe. Low water pressure may be experienced, you should leave your faucets off until pressure is restored. Customers with a water softener should by-pass them during the day to prevent any problems. Open Burning of yard waste only until June 1. Burning of any trash, leaves, rubbish or other material in any curb or gutter or on any paved street or alley is prohibited. To prevent plugging of storm drains or culverts do not put yard waste into storm or street ditches. There is no dumping in Little Bear Creek. Do not blow your grass into the street when mowing.
