Wyoming West Webster Street Water Project Extended
The City was able to extend the area of the project due to the USDA grant funding. The area from Little Bear Creek and west to North Oak Street along W. Green Street and W. Webster Street did not have water mains, only service lines providing water to the residents. This summer Kueter Equipment has been putting in six- inch mains and fire hydrants.

The City was able to fund the project with a USDA grant for the preliminary water study of \$16,000, USDA loan of 334,000 at 1.25% and a grant through USDA of \$226,000. The City also spent \$51,000 of water reserve funds for the water project. The engineering cost are estimated at \$85,000, legal fees \$17,500 and current contract with Kueter is \$363,824.15. The City will be able to use some of the grant funds for water equipment also.
