Council vacancy- If you are interested, contact City Hall for an application. Contact City Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 362.3 the Wyoming City Council intends to fill the vacancy by appointment at the November 8, 2022, regular meeting of the Wyoming City Council which commences at 7:00 p.m. The electors of Wyoming have the right to file a petition requiring that at the vacancy be filled by election. The petition must contain the signature and address of at least 10 eligible electors of Wyoming and be filed with the City Clerk no later than fourteen (14) days after the appointment is made or fourteen (14) days after the date of publication of this notice, whichever is later. If a legal petition is filed, the Council will call a special election as prescribed by the Iowa law and the appointment shall be temporary until the results of the special election are canvassed and the successful candidate is duly qualified.

Winter reminders...no parking on streets during snow removal. Snow and ice should be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours from the time it ceases to accumulate. If ice has accumulated and cannot be removed keep the sidewalk sprinkled with sand and/or salt to permit safe travel.

Open burning ends December 1st. Burning is prohibited in any curb and gutter, paved or surfaced street or alley. This includes culverts. Fires need to out by dusk.
