Winter reminders...no parking on streets during snow removal. Snow and ice should be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours from the time it ceases to accumulate. If ice has accumulated and cannot be removed keep the sidewalk sprinkled with sand and/or salt to permit safe travel.

Snowmobiles may only operate to go to or from the country by the most direct route: State Street, Pine Street, Green Street and Jones Street. Jefferson Street from Main to Jones to allow for fueling. Any person not living on a designated street may travel by the most direct route to the nearest street designated.
